

Policy on Sexual Assault Notification Options

In the event of a sexual assault occurring on the APU Campus, a student may contact local police agencies along with the Campus Safety office. If a student requires assistance in reporting a crime to the police, the Dean of Student office will provide support.

It is the policy of Alaska Pacific University following disciplinary actions for alleged sex offenses, that the accused and the complainant will both be notified of the outcome at the end of the process.

If a student not yet 18 years of age is involved in a sexual assault on the APU Campus or while associated with one of APU's programs, the University will report the assault to authorities and the parents of the minor involved in the incident.
