
Windows Instructions

Connect to the APU University network from a Windows Computer (on or off campus) running Windows 10 or later:

- 1. Make sure that you are running Windows 10 and have the latest updates.
- 2. Go to my.alaskapacific.edu and login.
- 3. Click the Microsoft Remote Desktop Tile



4. Click the "Microsoft Remote Desktop Token"



- 5. If prompted that the connection cannot be verified, click "Connect" and "Don't Ask Me Again...".
- 6. When prompted for your username, enter your email address.
- 7. Enter your password.

8. Connect.


Mac Instructions

Connect to the APU University network from a Mac: You must have Mac OS10.12 (Sierra) or later.

- 1. Install Microsoft Remote Desktop for Mac from the Mac App store.
- 2. Go to my.alaskapacific.edu and login.
- 3. Click the Microsoft Remote Desktop Tile



4. Click the "Microsoft Remote Desktop Token"



- 5. Enter your password.
- 6. Connect.
- 7. If it does not connect, "add a desktop" in the "Microsoft Remote Desktop" App using these credentials:

a. Computer Name: virtualdesktop.alaskapacific.edu

b. Gateway Server: gw.alaskapacific.edu

c. User Name: YourUserName@alaskapacific.edu

Important Information:

- Microsoft Remote Desktop will work on most Wi-Fi or cellular connections. However, inexpensive home routers or low-quality Wi-Fi connections may cause the connection quality to degrade or occasionally disconnect. If this occurs, APU IT will generally be unable to assist unless you connect your device to a wired or Ethernet connection.

- Microsoft Remote Desktop will not work on windows XP, 7, or 8.
