The Donovan Walsh Scholarship funded by GCI is for Alaska Native students or students from rural Alaska. Ten (10) \$2,000 Scholarships will be awarded for the 2022-2023 academic year. The application deadline to apply for the scholarship is April 1, 2022.

Criteria:

- Individual must be a degree seeking student in Good Academic Standing
- Individual must self-identify as Alaska Native or American Indian or be from rural Alaska. Rural is defined as an individual living outside of the Municipality of Anchorage, Mat-Su, Fairbanks, or Juneau.
- Enrolled at least part-time

Preferences:

- Preference for the Donovan Walsh Scholarship will be given to students who demonstrate financial need. Student will need to submit their FAFSA prior to submitting this application.
- The Scholarship will provide financial support toward a student's tuition and fees.
- Application deadline is April 1, 2022 11:59 pm AKDT.
