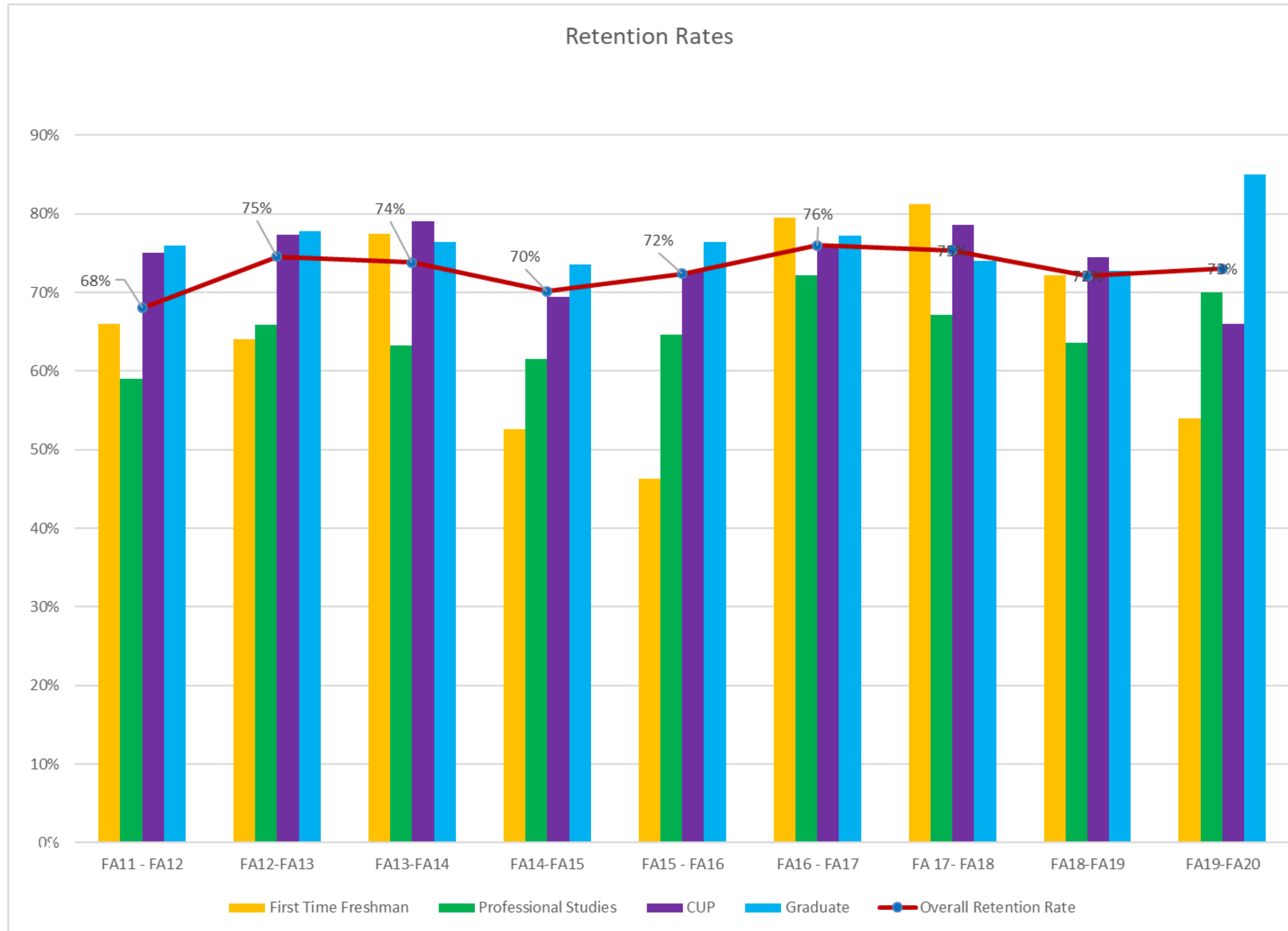

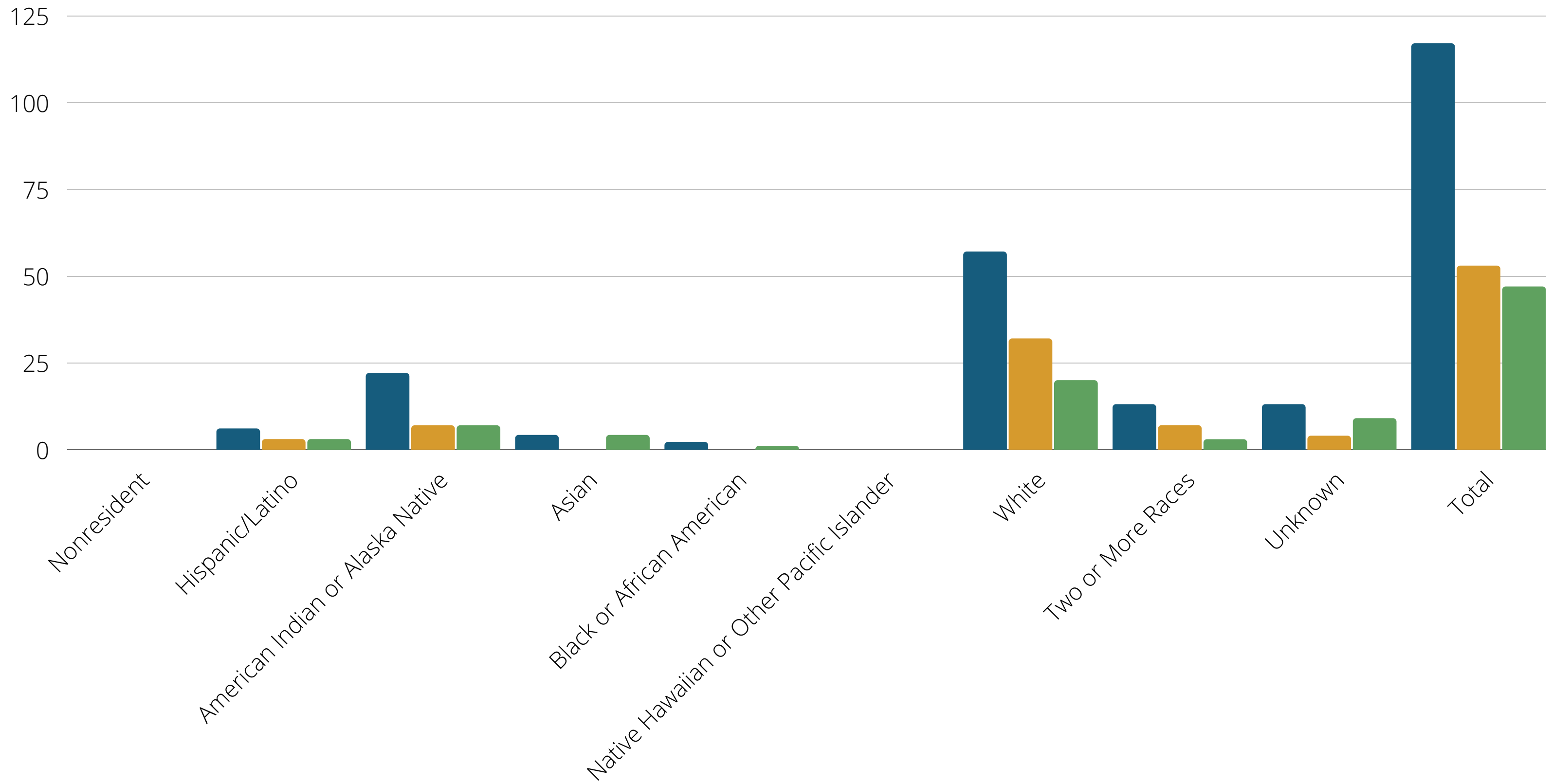


APU defines student retention as students who enroll consecutively from one fall semester to the next

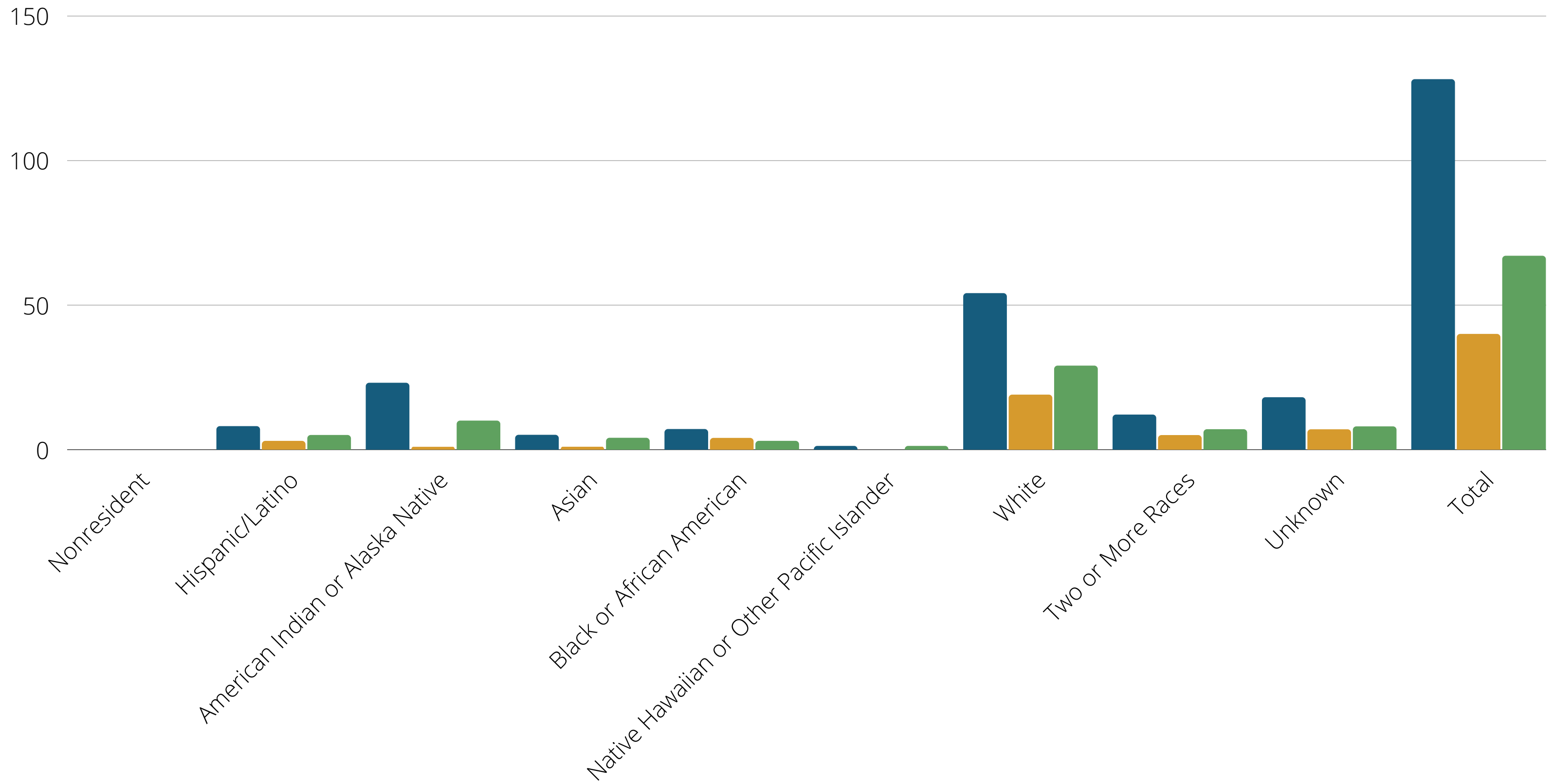

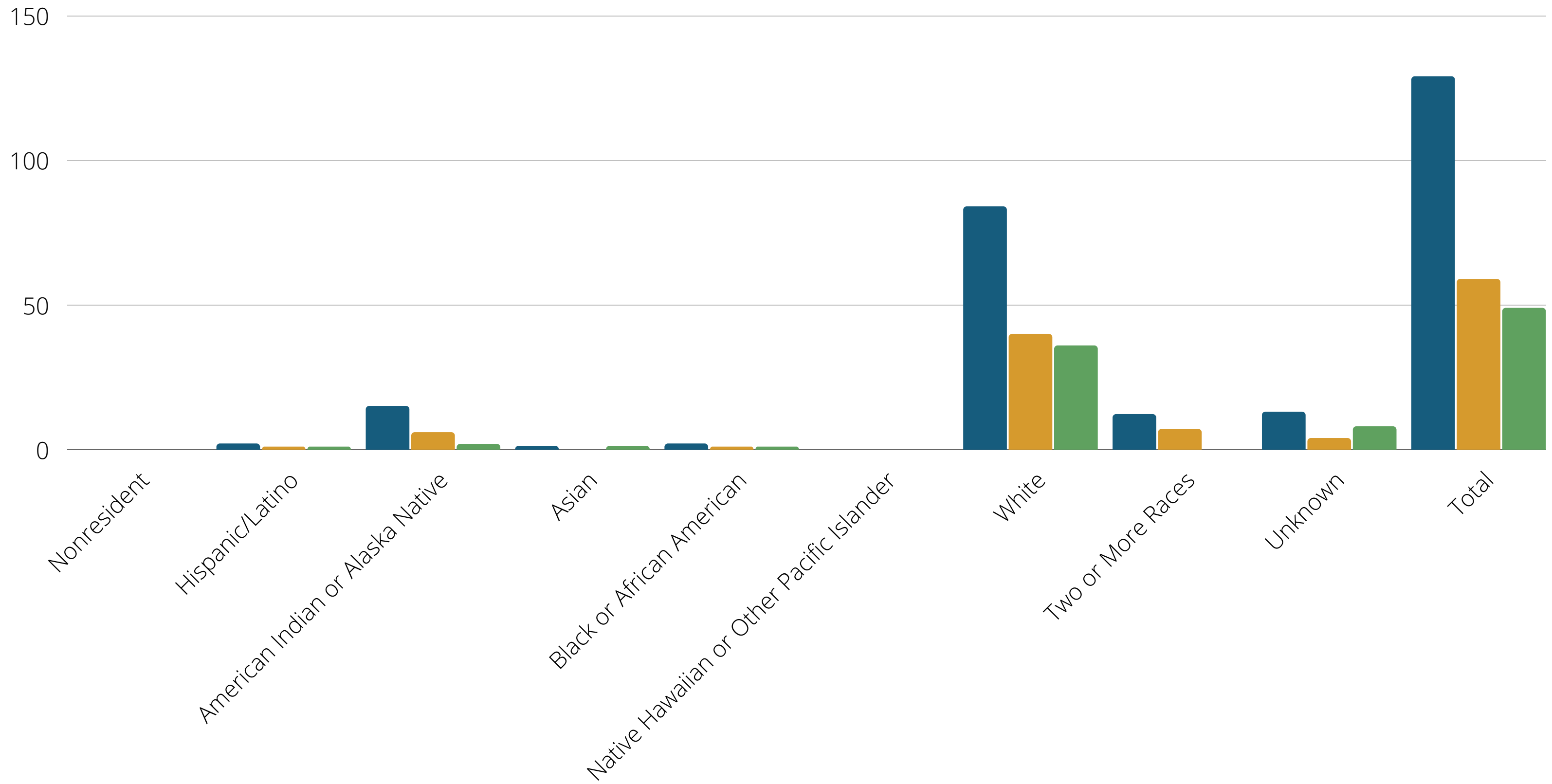

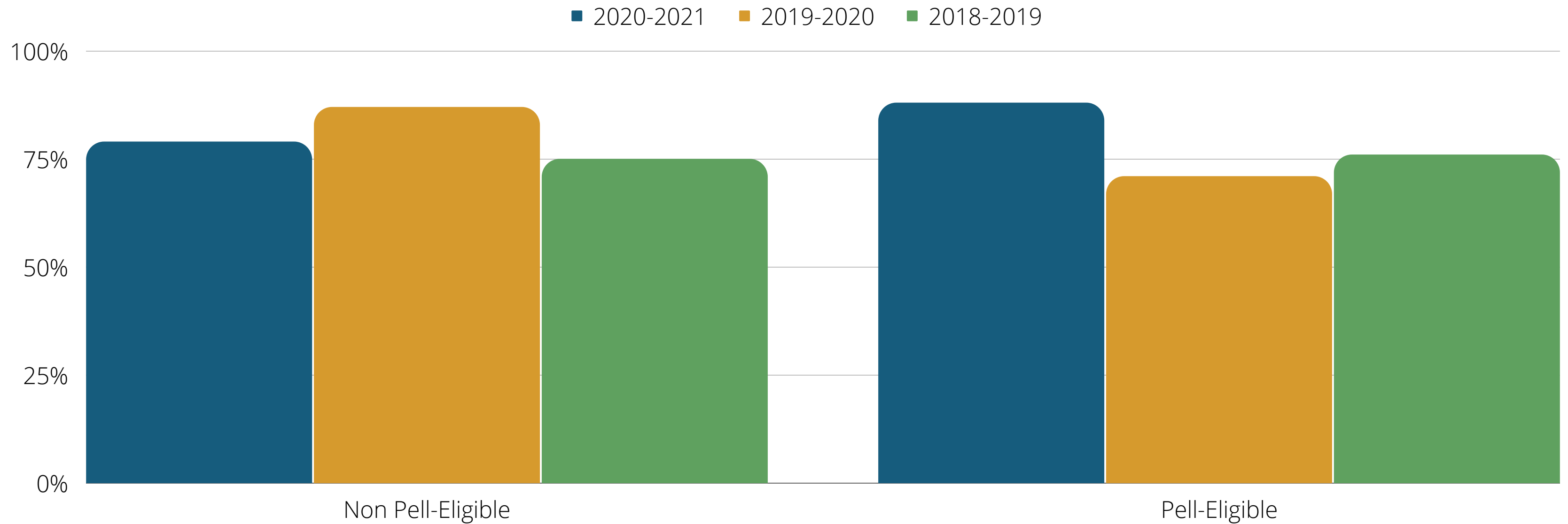

NEW STUDENT PERSISTENCE PELL-ELIGIBLE V. NON-ELIGIBLE

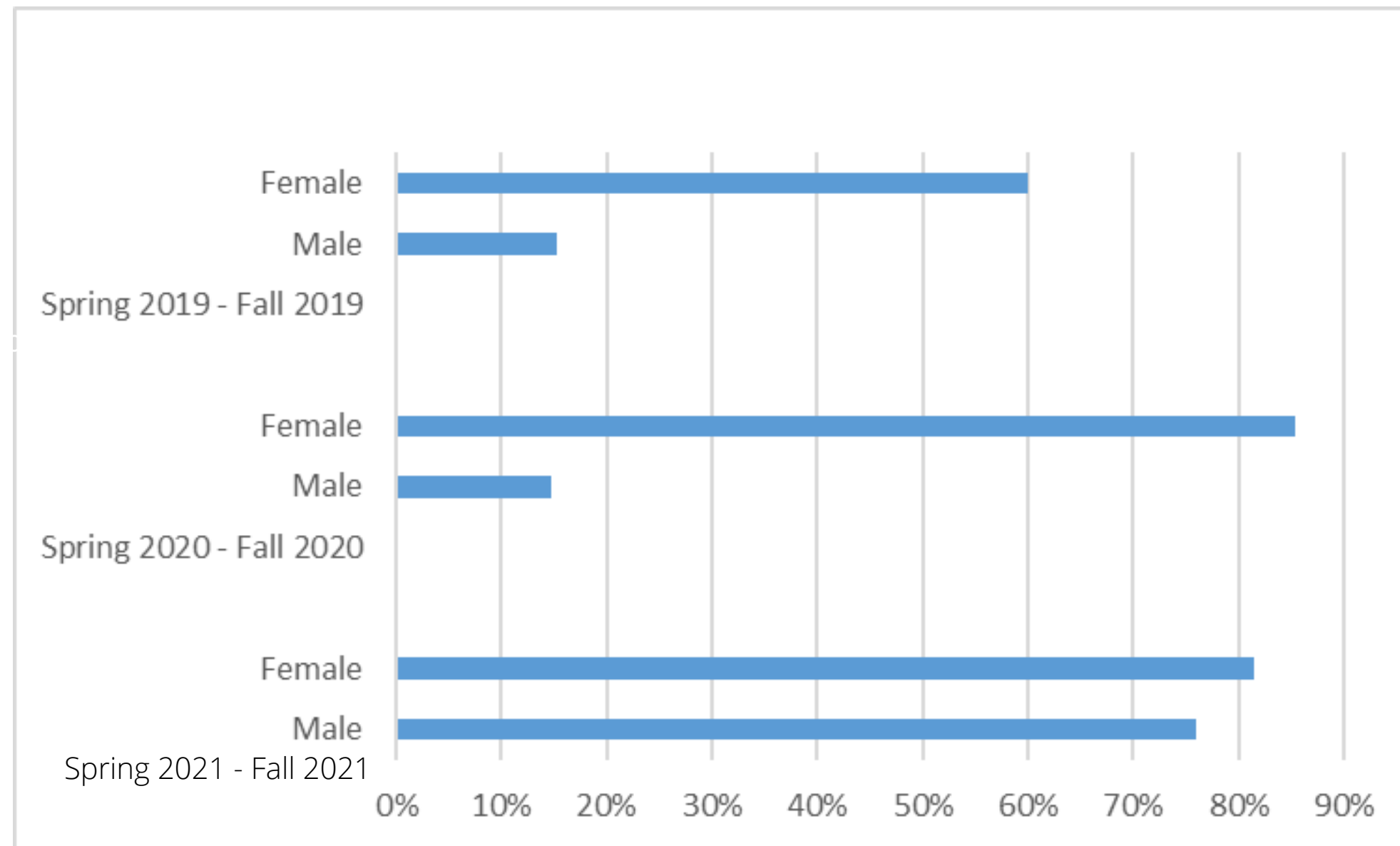
Persistence is defined by APU as students who attended in the Fall semester and returned for the next Spring semester

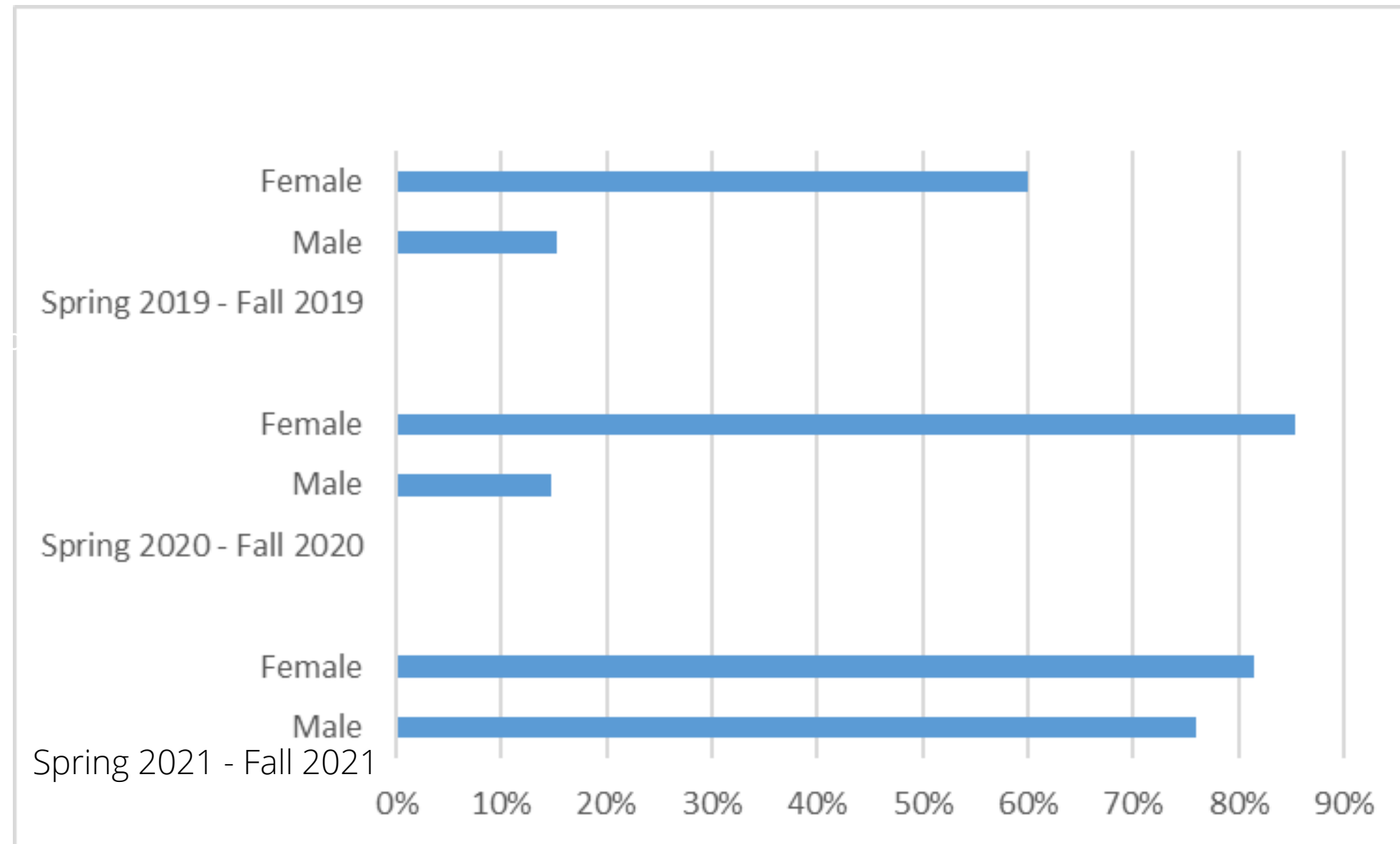
