

Late, Lost, Dirty, or Damaged Equipment

- A late fee of the daily rental rate will be assessed on a daily basis to each item that is not returned.
- Late charges are to be paid upon return of the equipment.
- Delinquent payments and misuse of equipment will result in loss of rental privileges.
- A **\$10 cleaning fee** will be assessed for equipment returned dirty or wet.
- Equipment that needs minor repair will be charged the cost of repair.
- Replacement/repair due to loss, damage, or theft is the responsibility of the renter and will be charged the full retail value of the item.

Packrafts & Sea Kayaks

If taking sea kayaks to the ocean or packrafts to the river, participants will need to take a safety course through Outdoor Programs or show previous experience. Packrafts are allowed on class II and below.

Rental Deposits

APU student, staff, faculty, or alumni may rent equipment without a deposit.
General Public and ANTHC Staff may rent equipment with a valid ID and credit card number on file.

Refund Policy

No credits or refunds are given for equipment returned early or unused.

Liability

The renter is responsible for inspecting the equipment and seeing that it is complete and in safe & satisfactory condition.
Renters use all equipment at their own risk.
Renters are encouraged to ask questions regarding the inherent risks involved in using the rental equipment.
