

Health Sciences Pre-Nursing

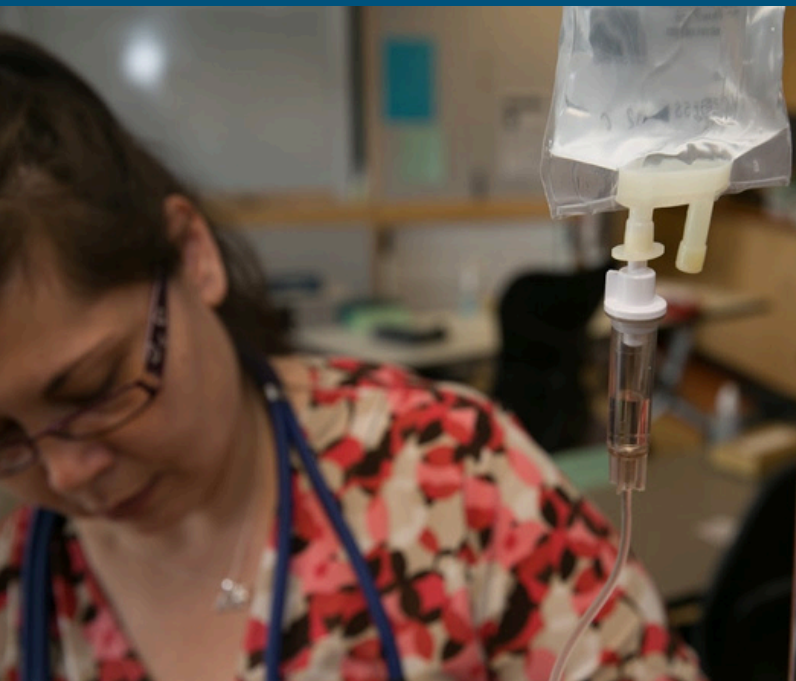
There is a high demand for registered nurses throughout the State of Alaska. Seeking to help meet this demand, APU has created the Pre-Nursing program. Pre-Nursing at APU is grounded in cultural safety and delivers the foundational knowledge and skills necessary for our students to successfully continue to APU's Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) program.

Pre-Nursing students can anticipate one year of full-time prerequisite Nursing coursework. Upon successful completion of this coursework, Pre-Nursing students are encouraged to apply to the Associate Degree in Nursing to work towards becoming a Registered Nurse. With the knowledge, skills, and abilities gained through our program graduates go onto provide holistic care for communities across Alaska.



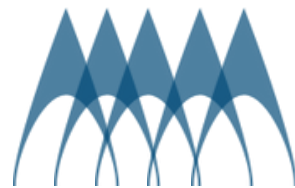
APU Pre-Nursing students who have successfully completed all prerequisite coursework with an extracted 3.0 prerequisite GPA and a 2.5 cumulative GPA are eligible to apply for the Associate Degree in Nursing.

Prerequisite coursework completed more than ten (10) years ago and any Nursing Major Courses are not eligible for transfer.

Applying to the ADN Program

Upon successfully completing the prerequisites, students are eligible to apply to the Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) program.

The Pre-Nursing program is a pathway to prepare students for the ADN subject matter. Applicants must meet the minimum qualifications for admission and submit all required documents to be considered for admission to the program. Admission to the ADN program is not guaranteed.

Students who do not gain admission to the ADN program are able to pursue another concentration within Health Sciences or may elect to change their major.

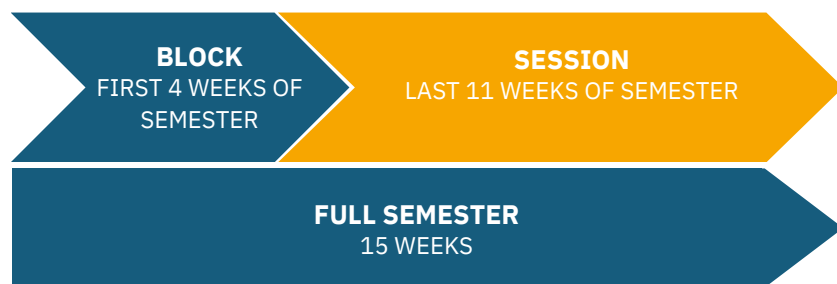
